Castleview and Church House at Amberley were two very different projects as part of the same contract.

Castleview provided five cottages, three two bedrooomed and two three bedrooomed, designed specifically to appeal to the 60+ age group that required manageable accommodation but in a worry-free and secure environment. The properties are designed to be future-proof for the requirements of the occupants whilst also having a manager to offer help and oversee day to day maintenace, security and alarm systems and the landscaped grounds. Each house has it's own patio and outdoor space designed for ease of access, use and maintenance.

Church House is the refurbished, detached vicarage immediately adjacent to Castleview. In a state of disrepair it was designed and modernised to offer 6 bedrooms, 3 bathrooms and all the accommodation you'd expect of a substantial country house in West Sussex.

As the names of both developments suggest they occupy the site immediately adjacent to St Michael's Church in Amberley and offer stunning views of the famous castle and the South Downs.
